Must have a certificate of screening.	Opening date : July 13
<b>Hotel Abri du voyageur</b>	53 places, mixed. Pets tolerated	Homeless people screened from two hatching resources. Under surveillance and awaiting a second screening.	<u>Only by referral</u>	Closing date : July 21

<b>Hospital COVID-19 units</b>	Mixed	Hospitalization for treatment and care
